

## Annual Membership Fees

In order to demonstrate solidarity with universities and other Higher Education Institutions based in low income countries, the SARUA institutional membership fee structure is based on a combination of institutional student enrollment and the Gross National Product (GNP) of the country. The financial year at SARUA runs from 1 January to 31 December.
